Incentivize Degree Completion with Direct Institutional "Bundy" Aid



The Direct Institutional "Bundy" Aid program provides the only source of direct, unrestricted funding from the state to private, not-for-profit colleges and universities. The funding level is based on the number of degrees a college or university awards. **The program is outcome-based and student-focused – colleges are incentivized to ensure more students get to graduation.**

For more than 50 years, Bundy Aid has provided critical funding used for student aid and other supports and that help ensure students get over the finish line to graduation. Bundy Aid has a strong track record of successfully reducing the cost of a college education for students, providing tremendous taxpayer value, and helping maintain balance in New York's higher education ecosystem. Bundy Aid funding has held flat for many years, and is funded at less than 20 percent of statutory levels. It is the ONLY source of unrestricted support for the 100+ private, not-for-profit colleges and universities in New York. **Private colleges confer 60 percent of the bachelor and graduate degrees in the state and educate nearly 500,000 students annually.** The state's investment in private colleges through Bundy Aid is an example a public-private partnership that works. **Increasing Bundy Aid funding would help private colleges provide more New York students affordable higher education.**
